
- Data and research staff that collects, manages, and analyzes agency administrative data under the direction of the SLDS Board




State Longitudinal Data System NSPARC as Mississippi's SLDS Clearinghouse

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

(Statistics for average annual earnings for three years and five years after graduation will not appear in the chart if enough time has not passed between the year of graduation and now.) 
